

# Resolution: 2023-01

## TOWN OF DOYLE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RESOLUTION TO APPROVE BROADBAND EXPANSION PROPOSAL FROM MOSAIC TECHNOLOGIES

WHEREAS, Town of Doyle Board (the "Board") strives in expansion of fiber optic broadband infrastructure and service available to its residents;

WHEREAS, Mosaic Technologies, ("Mosaic") is a provider of broadband services to the area in and around the Township;

WHEREAS, Mosaic presented a proposal for expansion of broadband services in the county (the "Mosaic Proposal") at a Town of Doyle meeting on 10/16/23. The Mosaic Proposal shall be part of a Wisconsin Public Service Commission Capital Projects Fund application for broadband expansion submitted on or before the grant cycle ending November 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Township Board determines the following:

1. Recitals The Recitals set forth above are true and correct, and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
2. Health, Welfare, and Safety. The Town's approval of this Resolution and the Mosaic Proposal is beneficial to the health, welfare, and safety of the Township's residents, taxpayers, and visitors.

The content of this Resolution was reviewed and discussed by this Town of Doyle meeting on 10/16/23, and voted to recommend that the Town of Doyle Board of Supervisors to approve public-private partnership with Mosaic Technologies and their proposal to expand broadband through the support of the PSC's Capital Projects Fund Broadband Infrastructure Program.
