

## ORDINANCE No. 2017-02

STATE OF WISCONSIN  
Town of Doyle  
Barron County

The Town Board of the Town of Doyle, Barron County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.17, Wis. stats. to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates town highways as heavy traffic routes in the town as follows:

A. In this ordinance, "heavy traffic" means all vehicles not operating completely on pneumatic tires and all vehicles or combination of vehicles, other than motor buses, designed or used for transporting property of any nature and having a gross weight of more than 20,000 pounds.

B. The following Town of Doyle highways are designated as heavy traffic routes and heavy traffic on the following town highways is restricted or prohibited as follows: 25th street from HWY C to 24th avenue and 24th avenue from 24th street to 27th street (HWY 48); through traffic is prohibited.

C. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

D. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted highways in violation of the above-noted restrictions or prohibitions. The first violation will be a warning. Any violation after that shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$250 and then \$500 after that.


This ordinance is effective on September 20, 2017.


