Ordinance No: 2015 - 04

The Town Board of the Town of Doyle, Barron County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. stats., to adopted this resolution.


This resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town roads in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. stats., effective August 17, 2015, speed limits on certain Town of Doyle town road is reduced as follows:, on 25<sup>th</sup> Street extended from 18<sup>th</sup> Ave to CTY HWY C and from HWY 48 to 24<sup>th</sup> Ave., speed limit reduced to 45 mph.
- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11 (5), Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this resolution.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town road in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. stats.

This resolution is effective on August 17, 2015.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
